DALIBOR BERNATOVIĆ

Dalibor Bernatović (1963) je na Srednji glasbeni šoli v Mariboru končal smer klarinet, na Srednji glasbeni in baletni šoli v Ljubljani pa smer harfa. Študiral je v Ljubljani na Akademiji za glasbo pri izr. prof. Rudi Ravnik Kosi ter na Akademiji za glasbo v Zagrebu (Muzičkoj Akademiji u Zagrebu) pri doc. prof. Mariji Mlinar, kjer je tudi diplomiral.

Prva redna zaposlitev je bila v Slovenskem narodnem gledališču Maribor, kjer je bil petnajst let solo harfist. Solistično, v orkestru ter v komornih zasedbah je koncertiral v mnogih državah Evrope. Ves ta čas je tudi poučeval na glasbenih šolah v Ljubljani, Novi Gorici, Celju, Velenju in Mariboru, kjer je sodeloval pri ustavnavljanju novih oddelkov za harfo. V pedagoškem delu je prisoten že kar trideset let ter ima pridobljen strokovni naziv svetnika. Aktivno, kot sestavljevec in predsednik strokovne komisije za harfo, je sodeloval v korikularni komisiji in pri prenovi ter pisanju novih učnih programov za glasbeno šolo in umetniško gimnazijo.

Redno je član mednarodnih komisij na harfističnih tekmovanjih doma in v tujini. Prav tako se uspešno ukvarja s skladanjem. Njegove skladbe so bile izvedene na mnogih koncertih po Sloveniji in v Amsterdamu, Madridu, Dunaju, Torinu, Cardiffu, Zagrebu, Rio de Janeiru, Lizboni in Beogradu.

Na področju Camac električne in elektroakustične harfe že več let predstavlja mladim glasbenikom nova obzorja in možnosti drugačnih pristopov do glasbe, zvoka in igranja harfe.

Kot ustanovitelj in predsednik Društva Harfistov Slovenije (1995-2020) je organiziral tekmovanja, mednarodne seminarje, koncerte ter druge oblike usposabljanja in sodelovanja harfistov.

Born in 1963, Dalibor Bernatović graduated from elementary school and the Secondary School of Music Conservatory in Maribor, Slovenia, where he studied the clarinet, and from the Secondary School of Music in Ljubljana, Slovenia, where he studied the harp.

He studied at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana in the class of Prof. Rudi Ravnik Kosi and graduated from the Music Academy in Zagreb, Croatia, with the mentorship of prof. Maria Mlinar.

15 years he was the Principal Harpist at the Slovenian National Theatre and Symphony orchestra Maribor. As a soloist, he performed with orchestras and chamber ensembles throughout the countries of the EU. All through this period he also worked at music schools in Ljubljana, Nova Gorica, Celje, Velenje, and Maribor, where he participated in the formation of new departments for harp music. He has been teaching music for 30 years and has been granted the title of councilor. He actively participated in the curriculum committee and in the revision and creation of a new harp curriculum, which he also co-authored.

Dalibor is regular member of national and international harp competitions. His compositions have been performed at numerous concerts across Slovenia, as well as in Amsterdam, Madrid, Vienna, Turin, Cardiff, Zagreb, Rio de Janeiro, Lisbon, and Belgrade.

In the field of Camac electrical and electro-acoustic harp, he is continuously working on a presentation to open new horizons and possibilities in sound and playing harps for young musicians.

As a President of the Slovenian Harp Association (1995-2020), he organized international seminars, harp competitions, concerts, and other forms of qualification and cooperation for harpists.

MARIA GAMBOZ GRADIŠNIK



Diplomirala je v Tokiju na Državni akademiji za lepo umetnost in glasbo pri prof. Sumire Kuwashima ter na Konservatoriju za glasbo v Trstu pri prof. Mariagrazii Trost Consoli, magistrirala pa z odliko v Vidmu pri prof. Patrizii Tassini. Ob študiju je opravila specializacijo na Accademia Chigiana v Sieni pri prof. Susanni Mildonian in prof. Fabrice-u Pierre-u. V času študija je zmagala na šestih tekmovanjih za štipendijo ter na petih mednarodnih tekmovanjih, med njimi tudi na tekmovanju Victor Salvi (Saluzzo, Italija) in TIM (Salone de Provence, Francija).

Kot solistka je nastopala z orkestri kot so Pomeriggi Musicali di Milano, Opera in Balet Ljubljana, Young Janáček Philharmonic, Orkestrom iz Londona in mnogimi italijanskimi komornimi orkestri. Kot komorna glasbenica je nastopala v znanih japonskih dvoranah kot so Santory Hall, Concert Hall Opera City in Art Sphere.

Jure Gradišnik, solo trobentač RTV Simfonikov, je njen življenjski sopotnik, s katerim redno nastopata širom Evrope in sta posnela zgoščenko Rustiques. Poleg tega si želi širiti harfistični repertoar. Objavila je številne priredbe in transkripcije za harfo v različnih komornih sestavih, ki so izdane pri založbah Curci in Pizzicato.

Kot solo harfistka je sodelovala z mnogimi orkestri: Australian Chamber Orchestra, Mozart Orchestra (Bologna), Orchestra Sinfonica della CR di Roma, Fondazione Lirica Teatro Verdi (Trst), Simfonični Orkester hrvaškega radia in televizije ter Simfonični Orkester RTV Slovenija.

Od leta 2008 je solo harfistka v Orkestru SNG Opera in balet Ljubljana, od leta 2007 pa redno sodeluje kot solo harfistka v orkestru OSI (Orchestra della Svizzera Italiana) v Luganu – Švica. Obenem poučuje harfo v glasbeni šoli Škofja Loka in redno izvaja seminarje za mlade harfiste v Sloveniji.

Maria Gamboz graduated in Tokyo, from the University of Fine Arts and Music with prof. Sumire Kuwashima, an Honours graduate in Trieste and in Udine under the guide of prof. Mariagrazia Trost Consoli and prof. Patrizia Tassini. She also studied in the Accademia Chigiana of Siena with prof. Susanna Mildonian and Fabrice Pierre. During her studies she won six scholarships in Italian competitions, and five international competition including the Victor Salvi Competition and the TIM (Salone de Provence, France).

She has appeared as a soloist with orchestras such as Pomeriggi Musicali in Milano, Opera and Ballet Ljubljana, Young Janáček Philharmonic Orchestra, and several Italian Chamber Orchestras. She has performed in many prestigious halls in Tokyo (Santory Hall, Concert Hall Opera City, Art Sphere).

In duo with her husband Jure Gradišnik (solo trumpet in the RTV Symphony Orchestra), she has recorded the CD *Rustiques* and performed in various festivals around Europe. In addition, she has always looked for new repertoire. She has published many arrangements and transcriptions for harp in different chamber formations, released by Curci and Pizzicato.

She has collaborated as the first harp with the Mozart Orchestra in Bologna, Symphony Orchestra of C.R. of Rome, Fondazione Lirica Teatro Verdi in Trieste, Simfonični Orkester RTV Slovenija, Friuli Venezia Giulia Symphony Orchestra in Udine, Filarmonia Veneta in Treviso, Symphony Orchestra of Perugia, and many others.

Since 2007 she has been collaborating as Principal Harp with the OSI (Orchestra della Svizzera Italiana - Switzerland), and since the season 2008 she is the Principal Harpist in Slovenian national theatre Opera and Ballet Ljubljana (Slovenia). She teaches in the Music School Škofja Loka, and regularly gives seminars for young Slovenian harpists.



DIANA GRUBIŠIĆ ĆIKOVIĆ

Diana Grubišić Ćiković je končala študij klavirja na Akademiji za glasbo v Zagrebu (Mužička akademija u Zagrebu) pri prof. Mariji Gvozdić Horvat. Iz harfe pa je diplomirala pri prof. Rudi Ravnik Kosi na Ljubljanski Akademiji za glasbo. Dvoletni podiplomski študij je končala na Visoki šoli za glasbeno umetnost v Lovranu pri prof. Irini Pašinskoj (Rusija).

Nastopa kot solistka in komorna glasbenica.

Do sedaj je igrala kot solistka ob spremljavi številnih orkestrov, kot so: Slovenska filharmonija, Orkester Opere HNK Ivana pl. Zajca v Reki, Dubrovniški simfonični orkester, Simfonični orkester hrvaškega radia in televizije, ansambel "Cantus", Varaždinski komorni orkester, Reški komorni orkester, Zadarski komorni orkester, Hrvaški komorni orkester in Madžarski simfonični orkester "Danubia". Nastopala je v Sloveniji, Avstriji, Italiji, Nemčiji, Belgiji, Rusiji, Avstraliji ter Južni in Severni Ameriki.

Snema za arhiv hrvaškega radia, do sedaj je posnela štiri zgoščenke. Več kot dvaindvajset let je bila solo harfistka Orkestra Opere HNK Ivana pl. Zajca na Reki. Od leta 1994 do 2006 je poučevala harfo na Glasbeni šoli Ivana Matetića Ronjgova na Reki. Od leta 2002 je profesorica za harfo na Akademiji za glasbo v Zagrebu in občasno sodeluje v orkestrih. Pogosto je članica žirije na domačih in mednarodnih harfističnih tekmovanjih ter mentorica mnogim harfistom v okviru harfističnih seminarjev.

Diana Grubišić Ćiković graduated from the piano at the Music Academy in Zagreb, University of Zagreb (Croatia) in 1988 in the class of prof. Marija Gvozdić Horvat, and harp at the Music Academy in Ljubljana (Slovenia) in 1994 in the class of prof. Ruda Ravnik Kosi. She continued with her postgraduate studies of harp at the Music Art Academy in Lovran and finished her two year postgraduate programme with prof. Irina Petrovna Pashinskaja (Russia).

She attended international harp masterclasses with prof. Catherine Michel (France) and Patrizia Tassini (Italy). So far she has given numerous recitals and performed as a soloist accompanied by the Orchestra of the Croatian National Theatre in Rijeka, the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra in Ljubljana, the Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra, Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, Rijeka Chamber Orchestra, Croatian Chamber Orchestra, Zadar Chamber Orchestra, Hungarian Symphony Orchestra "Danubia", "Cantus" ensemble, Croatian Radio and Broadcast Symphony Orchestra.

Besides she has also performed in various chamber ensembles (flute and harp duo with Tamara Coha Mandić, violin and harp duo with her sister Tea Grubišić and many others). She has recorded many compositions for Croatian Radio Record and Tape Library, a CD with the Rjeka piano trio, containing works by Croatian authors (Pejačević, Bjelinski, Gržinić) and several compact discs containing music for solo harp, flute and harp, voice and harp.

Diana has been a solo harpist at the Croatian National Theatre in Rijeka for 23 years and has also established an artistic cooperation with most orchestras in Croatia and Slovenia. She has been teaching harp from 1996 to 2006 at the Music school " Ivan Matetić Ronjgov" in Rijeka. Since 2002 she is the harp professor at the Music Academy University of Zagreb.

She regularly teaches harp courses and masterclasses and is a jury member of national and international harp competitions.



LENKA PETROVIĆ

Lenka Petrović je prvonagrajenka prestižnega dvajsetega mednarodnega harfističnega tekmovanja v Izraelu (International Harp Contest in Israel) in prva Srbkinja, ki je osvojila to nagrado. Na istem tekmovanju je prejela nagrado Irene Kaganovsky za najboljšo izvedbo skladbe Smetana/Trneček: Moldau.

Od leta 2019 je solo harfistka Simfoničnega orkestra Concerto Budapest na Madžarskem.

Nastopila je v Izraelu, na Kitajskem, v ZDA, Rusiji, Argentini, Italiji, na Poljskem, Madžarskem, Hrvaškem, v Srbiji in bila tudi predstavljena na Koncertu mladih talentov na Svetovnem harfističnem kongresu leta 2017 v Hong Kongu ter imela recital na Svetovnem harfističnem kongresu leta 2022 v Cardiffu.

Kot solistka z orkestrom je sodelovala z Israel Philharmonic Orchestra, Orchestra I Pomeriggi Musicali (Milano), Haifa Symphony Orchestra, The Handel Festival Orchestra (New York), Concerto Budapest Symphony Orchestra, Ensemble Metamorphosis (Beograd), Summer Philharmonic Orchestra of Indiana University in Symphonic Orchestra of Academy of Arts (Novi Sad).

Lenka je nagrajenka številnih tekmovanj, vključno s 3. nagrado in nagrado za izvedbo skladbe Sublimation Jeremija Siochija na 10. mednarodnem harfističnem tekmovanju ZDA (USA International Harp Competition) v Bloomingtonu. Je dobitnica prve nagrade in posebne nagrade HarpMasters na 20. mednarodnem tekmovanju Petar Konjović v Beogradu. Leta 2017 je bila štipendistka New Horizons na Aspen Music Festival and School, leta 2014 in 2015 pa se je udeležila mednarodne poletne akademije za harfo HarpMasters Academy v Švici. Lenka, rojena leta 1995 v Beogradu, je z učenjem harfe začela pri 8 letih. Diplomirala je na Akademiji umetnosti v Novem Sadu, pri profesorici Staši Mirković in magistrirala leta 2019 na The Juilliard School pri solo harfistki Newyorške filharmonije Nancy Allen.

Lenka Petrović is the first prize winner of the prestigious 20th International Harp Contest in Israel in 2018 and is the first Serbian to win this prize. Additionally, she was awarded the Irina Kaganovsky prize for the best performance of Bedřich Smetana/Trneček: Moldau at the same competition. Since 2019 Lenka is the principal harpist of the Concerto Budapest Symphony Orchestra in Hungary.

She has performed in Israel, China, USA, Russia, Argentina, Italy, Poland, Hungary, Croatia, Serbia and was also featured at the Young Talent Concert at the 2017 World Harp Congress in Hong Kong and performed a recital at the 2022 World Harp Congress in Cardiff. As a soloist with orchestra, Lenka has performed concertos with musicians of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra, Orchestra I Pomeriggi Musicali in Milan, Haifa Symphony Orchestra, The Handel Festival Orchestra in New York, Concerto Budapest Symphony Orchestra, Ensemble Metamorphosis in Belgrade, Summer Philharmonic Orchestra of Indiana University and Symphonic Orchestra of Academy of Arts in Novi Sad.

Lenka is a laureate of numerous competitions including the 2016 Bronze Medal and Willy Postma Composition Prize for the Best Performance of Jeremiah Siochi's Sublimation at the 10th USA International Harp Competition in Bloomington. She is also the 2015 winner of the first prize and a special prize from HarpMasters Academy in Switzerland at the 20th International Competition Petar Konjović in Belgrade. Lenka was a New Horizons Fellow at the Aspen Music Festival and School in 2017 and also attended the International Summer Harp Academy "HarpMasters" in Switzerland in 2014 and 2015.

Born in Belgrade, Serbia in 1995, Lenka began learning the harp at age 8. In 2017, she received a Bachelor's degree in harp performance from the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad, where she studied with prof. Staša Mirković. Lenka received a Master's degree from The Juilliard School in 2019, studying with New York Philharmonic's principal harpist Nancy Allen.



ŞIRIN PANCAROĞLU

S strani Washington Posta je bila prepoznana kot velik talent mednarodnih razsežnosti. Odkrivanje različnih glasbenih identitet za harfo je njeno osrednje prizadevanje. Kljub klasični izobrazbi na Geneva Conservatory in Indiana University Jacobs School of Music je ta vodilna turška harfistka enako aktivna tudi v tradicionalni turški glasbi, improviziranju, elektronski glasbi, tangu, odrskih uprizoritvah, z deli napisanih zanjo pa širi harfističen repertoar.

Priznana po izredni interpretaciji in večplastni glasbeni osebnosti, je solistično in komorno koncertirala v več kot dvajsetih državah. Do danes je posnela 12 zgoščenk. S poslušalci deli svoje glasbene korenine, ki jih povezuje s svetovnimi idejami. Odkrivanje zgodovinske turško-ottomanske harfe „çeng“, jo je pripeljalo do bližnjega spoznavanja tradicionalne glasbe. Preko priredb in transkripcij tradicionalne glasbe, se je nanjo dodatno navezala s komponiranjem svojih skladb.

Şirin je avtorca projekta »Turkish Harp«, katerega cilj je predstaviti turško glasbo harfistom po vsem svetu. Kot urednica »The Turkish Harp Music Collection« je marljivo delala na izboru stare in nove glasbe, ki jo je združila tudi z nekaterimi svojimi skladbami. Z mojstrskimi tečaji, ki temeljijo na tej publikaciji, deli znanje amaterjem, študentom in profesionalnim harfistom pedalne in keltske harfe.

Trenutno snema avtorske skladbe, ki bodo dopolnile nov album z naslovom “Alaim-i Sema” (Mavrica). Şirin se počuti zelo počaščeno, da se je izobraževala pri Susann McDonald, Catherine Eisenhoffer, Notburgi Puskas, Pierru Jametu in Frederique Cambrelingu. Z možem in sinom živi v Urli, majhnem mestu na obali Egejskega morja v Turčiji.

Praised by the Washington Post as a “major talent of international caliber”, for Şirin Pancaroğlu, discovering a variety of musical identities for the harp is a central endeavor. Trained as a classical harpist at Geneva Conservatory and Indiana University Jacobs School of Music, she is equally active in the realm of Turkish music, improvisation, contemporary music, tango, and semi-staged performances as she is in mainstream harp repertoire. Regular collaborations with performers and composers of diverse backgrounds have led Pancaroğlu to cross boundaries between musical styles often resulting in music that has been perceived as opening the path to new genres.

Recognized for her thorough interpretative skills and multifaceted personality, Şirin has been presenting collaborative projects, and concerts in over twenty countries and has twelve recordings to her credit. She also has been devoted to sharing her musical roots with audiences, connecting them to her worldly ideas. Her work on unearthing the historical Turco-Ottoman harp, the çeng, led her to become closely acquainted with traditional Turkish music. First transcribing and arranging from the traditional Turkish music repertoire, she later started composing music for harp with ties to the tradition and beyond.

Şirin is the creator of “Turkish Harp”, a project aimed at introducing Turkish music to harpists worldwide. As editor of “The Turkish Harp Music Collection”, she has been diligently working on a selection of old and new Turkish music which she combined with some of her compositions as well. Conceived for lever and pedal harps and addressing different profiles such as amateur players, students, and professionals she is also preparing to conduct Turkish music workshops for harpists based on her publications. She is currently recording a series of singles which will add up to a new album, entitled “Alaim-i Sema” (Rainbow), consisting only of her own music. Şirin feels very lucky to have received the teachings of Susann McDonald, Catherine Eisenhoffer, Notburga Puskas, Pierre Jamet, and Frederique Cambreling. She lives in Urla, a small town on the Aegean coast of Turkey with her husband and son.



PATRIZIA TASSINI

Patrizia Tassini je študirala harfo z Evelino Vio na konservatoriju Giuseppe Tartini v Trstu, kjer je diplomirala z odliko "cum laude". Študirala je v Franciji in ZDA na Eastman šoli za glasbo, univerzi v Rochesteru (New York).

Naredila je magisterij ter si pridobila naziv tako iz koncertnega kakor tudi iz pedagoškega dela magisterija. Dobila je prvo nagrado na drugem mednarodnem harfističnem tekmovanju v Varallu, leta 1982 je dobila drugo nagrado na mednarodnem harfističnem tekmovanju v Izraelu in leta 1984 na koncertnem tekmovanju v ZDA. Snemala je za italijanski nacionalni radio (RAI) in francoski radio.

Bila je čanica žirije na mednarodnem harfističnem tekmovanju v Izraelu, na harfističnem tekmovanju Martin Geliot v Lillu, na nacionalnem konservatoriju Supérieur v Parizu, harfističnem tekmovanju Félix Godefroid v Tournai-u, mednarodnem harfističnem tekmovanju v Beogradu (Srbija) in Bloomingtonu (ZDA). Sodelovala je s flavtisti Maxencom Larrieujem, Giorgiem Marcossijem, Massimom Mercellijem, z Mainškim komornim orkestrom, zagrebškimi solisti in s srbskim RTV orkestrom. Leta 2002 je bila izbrana v glavni odbor direktorjev za svetovni harfistični kongres (WHC). V zadnjih letih je imela koncerte in mojstrske tečaje po vsej Evropi, na Kitajskem, Taiwanu in Turčiji. Vodi harfistični orkester "Ventaglio d'Arpe" in je dolga leta učila harfo na konservatoriju Jacopo Tomadini v Vidmu (Italija).

Patrizia Tassini studied harp with Evelina Vio at the Giuseppe Tartini Conservatory of Trieste, graduating “cum laude”. She studied in France and the USA at the Eastman School of Music, University of Rochester (New York), getting a Master’s Degree in Performance and Literature and a Performance Certificate.

She won the I prize at the II International Harp Competition in Varallo; in 1982 the II prize at the International Harp Competition in Israel and in 1984 the USA Concerto Competition. She has recorded for the Italian National Radio Network (RAI) and Radio France.

She was on the jury of the International Harp Competition in Israel, the Martin Geliot Harp Competition in Lille, the Prix at the Conservatoire National Supérieur in Paris, the Félix Godefroid Harp Competition in Tournai, the International Harp Competition in Belgrade (Serbia) and Bloomington (USA).

She has a collaboration with the flutists Maxence Larrieu, Giorgio Marcossi, and Massimo Mercelli, with the Mainz Kammerorchester, the Zagreb Soloists, and the Serbian Radio Television Orchestra. In 2002 she has been elected to the Board of Directors of the World Harp Congress. Recently she has held concerts and masterclasses around Europe, in China, Taiwan, and Turkey. She conducts the Harp Orchestra “Ventaglio d’Arpe” and taught harp at the Jacopo Tomadini Conservatory of Udine (Italy)



DR. IRINA ZINGG

Vizija, talent, predanost, entuziazem in energija so rusko-švicarski harfistki dr. Irini Zingg zagotovili mednarodno priznanje in spoštovanje. Je profesorica harfe na Civica Scuola di Musica Claudio Abbado v Milenu ter ustanoviteljica in umetniška vodja HarpMasters akademije in festivala. Rodila se je v Moskvi, kjer je z odliko končala študij na Moskovskem državnem konservatoriju Čajkovski pod okriljem prof. Milde Agazarian in Olge Erdely. Ne samo, da jo je njena kariera vodila po svetu,

ampak je tudi njena umetniška dejavnost raznolika: sega od izvajanja do snemanja in širjenja obzorij harfe na Bližnjem vzhodu v devetdesetih letih prejšnjega stoletja, do njenega trenutnega svetovnega poučevanja. Doktorat je zaključila na glasbeni akademiji Gnessin v Moskvi in je avtorica številnih člankov, predgovorov in predavanj o zgodovini ruske harfe.

Irinina poklicna predanost se izraža v njenem nenehnem delu v harfistični skupnosti: je ustanovna članica mednarodnega združenja russkih učiteljev harfe, bila je članica upravnega odbora Moskovske kulturne fundacije in dopisnica WHC Review. Leta 2006 je ustanovila svetovno priznano HarpMasters – Academy, Festspiele, Edition in HM On the Road, ki danes služi kot pomembna vez med generacijami harfistov, hkrati pa zbira, ohranja in pospešuje mednarodno tradicijo harfe.

Irina je mednarodno cenjena harfistična pedagoginja, ki po vsem svetu poučuje na rednih seminarjih in delavnicah ter je kot gostujoča profesorica vabljena na pomembne svetovne glasbene ustanove v Italiji, Rusiji, Nemčiji, Veliki Britaniji, ZDA, idr. Poleg tega redno sodeluje v žirijah večjih mednarodnih harfističnih tekmovanj med njimi - International Harp Competition v Bloomingtonu in Israel International Harp Contest. Njeni učenci so osvojili najvišje nagrade na mednarodnih tekmovanjih za harfo v Izraelu, Italiji, Mehiki, na Nizozemskem, Portugalskem, Rusiji, Sloveniji, Srbiji, Španiji in Združenem kraljestvu ter razvijajo uspešne kariere kot izvajalci in učitelji.

Vision, talent, dedication, enthusiasm, and energy have granted the Russian-Swiss harpist Irina Zingg international recognition and appreciation. Dr. Irina Zingg is a Professor of harp at the Civica Scuola di Musica Claudio Abbado in Milano and Founder and Artistic Director of the HarpMasters Academy & Festival. Born in Moscow, Irina studied with professors Milda Agazarian and Olga Erdely and holds a degree with honors from Moscow State Tchaikovsky Conservatory. Not only has her career brought her around the world, but her artistic activity is also varied: it ranges from performing, to recording and expanding harp horizons in the Middle East in the 1990s through to her current worldwide teaching. She also holds a Ph.D. from the Gnessin Music Academy in Moscow and is the author of numerous articles, forewords, as well as lectures on Russian Harp History.

Irina's professional dedication translates into her ceaseless work serving the harp community: she is the Founding Member of the Association of Russian Harp Teachers International, has served as a Board Member of the Moscow Cultural Foundation, and as a Correspondent for the WHC Review. In 2006 she founded the worldwide recognized HarpMasters – Academy, Festspiele, Edition, and HM On the Road - which serves today as a significant liaison between generations of harpists while gathering, preserving, and furthering the international harp traditions.

Irina is a sought-after internationally appreciated harp pedagogue, who teaches worldwide regular seminars and workshops and is regularly invited as a guest professor at major world musical institutions in Italy, Russia, Germany, the UK, and the USA – among others. Furthermore, she regularly serves on the jury panels of major international harp competitions among them - USA International Harp Competition and Israel International Harp Contest.

Her students have won top prizes at international harp competitions in Israel, Italy, Mexico, the Netherlands, Portugal, Russia, Slovenia, Serbia, Spain, and the UK and develop successful careers both as performers and teachers.
